<b>Achillea Ptarmica Pearl</b>	Pure white flower clusters, very hardy and long flowering. 60 cm	
<b>Acorus gramineus 'Ogon'</b>	Japanese rush. Yellow/green leaves in fan shaped formation. 25cm	
<b>Agapanthus campanulatus</b>	Clump forming perennial with rounded umbrels of blue flowers. Hardy.	
<b>Agapanthus Inapertus</b>	As above but darker blue and smaller flowers.	
<b>Agastache apricot sprite.</b>	Rich apricot spikes of tasselled florets. Dwarf and compact. 46cm	
<b>Agastache Golden Jubilee</b>	Violet flowers over golden foliage in summer. 50cm. Award winner for garden performance	
<b>Ajuga Reptans</b>	Bugle. Creeping semi-evergreen green leaves Spike-like dark-blue flowers. Height 15cm. Spread 80cm. Flower colour Blue. Flowers from April to August.	
<b>Alchemilla Mollis</b>	Thrives in shady conditions. Pretty leaves with acid yellow/green flowers. 50cm	
<b>Anthemis Bright Yellow</b>	Clump-forming free-flowering perennial, leaves mid-green above and grey beneath. Solitary, golden yellow flowerheads. Height 80cm. Spread 80cm. Flowers from May to September.	
<b>Anthemis punctata subsp. Cupaniana</b>	Mat-forming perennial with dense silvery grey leaves. Bears long lasting white daisy-like flowerheads with a yellow centre from May to July. Excellent ground cover or over a wall 30cm	

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<b>Anthemis tinctoria Sauce Hollandaise</b>	Clump-forming, free flowering perennial, leaves mid-green above and grey beneath. Branching stems of pale cream, almost white flowerheads. 80cm	
<b>Aquilegia Swan Blue and White</b>	Blue and white flowers. 45-60cm	
<b>Aquilegia Swan mixed</b>	Excellent range of strong colours. 45-60cm	
<b>Armeria Large flower mix</b>	Cushion shaped grassy foliage and long stemmed bright globular blooms. Fleuroselect award. Good rockery plant 20cm	
<b>Artemesia Oriental Limelight</b>	Variegated bright green/yellow foliage. Flowers insignificant. Ht 60cm spread 60cm. Tolerates shade and brightens dull spot	
<b>Artemesia Powis Castle</b>	Evergreen silver foliage plant. Hardy. 45cm	
<b>Artemesia Schmidt Nana</b>	Low growing, spreading silver foliage plant with pale yellow flowers in summer.	
<b>Arthropodium cirratum (Renga lily)</b>	White lily flower from NZ	
<b>Astilbe Etna</b>	Upright dark red plumes with deep green foliage. 60cm Flo Jun/Jul	
<b>Aubretia Royal Mix</b>	Evergreen, compact perennial with large vivid coloured flowers. Alpine. Flo March-May 15cm	
<b>Campanula Porschyanaka</b>	Low growing, spreading bellflower, flowers twice in the season. Blue flowers. Hardy and reliable.	
<b>Carex Variegata</b>	Variegated bright green/yellow foliage. Flowers insignificant. Ht 60cm spread 60cm. Tolerates shade and brightens dull spot	
<b>Centaurea Montana</b>	Mat-forming robust perennial with narrow mid-green leaves woolly beneath. Woolly stems carry blue flowerheads with reddish violet petals. 45cm	
<b>Cerastium Tomentosum Yo-yo</b>	Snow in summer. Plant is smothered in white flowers in June/July. 10cm. Spreading. Hardy	
<b>Ceratostigma plumbagioides</b>	Spreading perennial with slender red stems and bright, green leaves, with wavy margins, tinted red in autumn. Brilliant blue flowers. 25cm	





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<b>Cerithe Major</b>	Glaucous green leaves bearing bracts of blue/purple. 30-45 cm. Sheltered site. Give colour from summer through Autumn. Gently self-seeds	
<b>Cistus Purpureus</b> and others, various varieties	A dense bushy shrub with slightly hairy, grey-green leaves. Pretty saucer-shaped clear pink flowers in summer.	
<b>Commelina Dianthifolia</b>	A small perennial with narrow green leaves and deep blue flowers from May to July. Height 10-15cm. Spread 8cm Height 10-15cm. Spread 8cm. PROTECT FROM WINTER WET.	
<b>Corydalis Flexuosa Blue</b>	An erect perennial with bronze tinted filigree green leaves and dense racemes of bright, slender tubed, wedgewood blue flowers. Prefers a cool moist position. Summer dormant. 30cm. Flowers early spring	
<b>Corydalis Lutea</b>	An evergreen perennial with light green divided leaves and racemes of golden yellow flowers. Self-seeds. 30cm	
<b>Corydalis ochroleuca</b>	An evergreen clump-forming perennial with light green divided leaves and racemes of creamy white flowers with yellow throats. Self-seeds freely. 30cm	
<b>Crocsmia (Montbretia) Orange</b>	Montbretia - a well known cottage garden plant. Likes a dry, sunny position. 18"	
<b>Crocsmia Lucifer Red</b>	A bold perennial with pleated, sword-like mid-green leaves. Arching, branched spikes of upward-facing, funnel-shaped, bright red flowers.	
<b>Delphinium elatum Magic Fountains</b>	Perennial flowering in 1st season. 80cm.	
<b>Delphinium grandiflorum Diamonds Blue</b>	Dazzling electric blue flowers - June to August. Spurless variety with upward turned florets. 70-80cm HP	


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<b>Delphinium Pacific Hybrids</b>	1.8m vigorous tall variety with good colour range in mixture. May need staking	
<b>Delphinium Tall Blue</b>	Up to 2m tall dark blue flowers.	
<b>Delphinium Guardian mix</b>	60-90cm. Flowers produced in succession through the summer	
<b>Dianthus F1 Plumarius Sweetness mixed</b>	Heavily perfumed flowers from July-Sept. Will come again next year.	
<b>Dianthus F1 Festival White Flame</b>	Very large blooms up to 4cm across. Has winter hardiness and summer heat tolerance. Bright green leaves with lace edged flowers. 20-25cm	
<b>Dianthus F1 Sweet</b>	30" , fragrant, single flowers. Excellent border and cut flower	
<b>Dianthus Valda Wyatt</b>	A bold perennial with pleated, sword-like mid-green leaves. Arching, branched spikes of upward-facing, funnel-shaped, bright red flowers.	
<b>Dierama pink</b>	A clump-forming perennial with grass-like leaves. Graceful arching stems of delicate, bell-shaped deep pink, occasionally purple-red or white flowers. 1m. Flowers from July to Aug. Angel Fishing Rods	
<b>Digitalis parviflora</b>	Dense, slender spikes of orange-brown flowers each with a purple-brown lip. Distinctive and striking. 60cm. Also called Chocolate Soldier!	
<b>Doronicum Little Leo</b>	Early flowering March-June, bright yellow daisy flowers.	
<b>Dracocephalum Argunense Fuji Blue</b>	A clump-forming with small hairy leaves. Pretty bluish purple tubular flowers on leafy stems. 45cm "Dragon's Head"	
<b>Erigeron Glaucus</b>	Tufted perennial with succulent-looking leaves. Semi double mauve daisy flowers in late spring - mid summer. 30 cm tall, 45cm spread. Evergreen and good ground cover	


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<b>Erigeron karvinskianus Profusion</b>	Spanish daisy - delicate white daisy flowers tinged pink. Flower all summer and late into Autumn. Survive in very dry spot, but also happy in normal growing conditions. 25cm. Hardy	
<b>Erodium Reichardii white/ pink</b>	A pretty mound-forming alpine with saucer-shaped white, red veined flowers on very short stems. 8cm. Long flowering throughout summer.	
<b>Euphorbia Golden Foam</b>	Red stems and fluffy "gypsophila" type heads of golden yellow flowers. 24-30cm. Dry location	
<b>Fascicularis bicolour</b>	Spiny toothed deep green leaves, in summer each rosette produces pale blue flowers surrounded by white bracts. 18-20". Will stand hard frost as long as it is planted in perfect drainage eg in a wall or bank.	
<b>Ferns Polystichum setiferum</b>	An attractive fern with shuttlecocks of deeply divided, green, lacey fronds. Height 50-70cm. Spread 50-70cm. Evergreen. Foliage colour Green. Hardy. Protect crowns from winter wet.	
<b>Fuchsia Hardy various</b>	Selection of hardy fuchsias available	
<b>Gaillardia Arizona Sun</b>	Bright large bicolour red/yellow "Blanket Flower". Likes a sunny position. Flowers through summer and well into autumn. 30cm	
<b>Geranium blue hardy</b>	Flowering in June/July this hardy geranium of upright habit reaches 30cm.	
<b>Geranium Johnstone Blue</b>	Large, dark-veined, lavender-blue flowers that fade to pearl grey as they mature. Ht 30cm. Spread 60cm. May to August. Part shade, to full sun	
<b>Geraniums Endressii</b>	A mat of almost evergreen deeply cut and pointed light green leaves. Bright pink, funnel-shaped flowers. Survives hot dry conditions and flowers all summer and into Autumn. Cut back mid season for repeat flowering.	
<b>Hedera Helix mixed</b>	Selection of Ivies available	





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<b>Helichrysum Italicum Korma</b>	A bushy evergreen subshrub with woolly stems and narrow silver-grey leaves gently smelling of curry. Yellow flowerheads from summer to autumn. Likes sunny, well drained position. Avoid winter wet. 60cm.	
<b>Hemerocallis Orange</b>	Orange flowered day lily. Flowers May/June. 60-90cm Hardy perennial	
<b>Hollyhock mixed</b>	Single flowered hollyhocks 5-10ft.	
<b>Hydrangea Mop cap White, Pink</b>	Medium height shrub requiring adequate moisture for good flowering. 1m. Huge white balls of flower! Pink variety slightly smaller.	
<b>Iberis Betty Swainson</b>	Large white flowers appear in May and bloom as long as the temperature remains moderate. Grows 10" tall and, like all Iberis, should be cut back after flowering. Flowers five times the size of sempervirens type Iberis.	
<b>Iberis Candytuft</b>	Orange flowered day lily. Flowers May/June. 60-90cm Hardy perennial 25cm	
<b>Iris sibirica</b>	Vigorous clumps of bushy leaves and tall stems of violet-blue flowers with veining on the falls in early summer. Likes damp/wet conditions. Height 60-120cm	
<b>Iris unguicularis</b>	Vigorous clumps of grass-like evergreen leaves and fragrant, pale lavender to deep violet flowers with a band of yellow on the falls. Flowers in deepest winter!	
<b>Lamium Pink Pearls</b>	Green/silver leaf and many pink flowers almost continually on this mat forming perennial. Good ground cover	
<b>Lampranthus spectabile magenta</b>	Low growing succulent with bright pink daisy flowers. Will survive short periods of frost to -7C. Well drained position in full sun.	
<b>Lapeyrusia Alba</b>	Small bulbous rockery plant. Delicate white flowers with red centres. If happy in its situation will seed itself. 10cm	
<b>Lapeyrusia Cruenta</b>	Small bulbous plant. Delicate red flowers in summer. Seeds itself to form good clump but not invasive. Rockery. 10cm	

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<b>Lathyrus latifolius</b>	A climbing perennial with winged stems and blue-green leaves and red flowers from summer to early autumn.	
<b>Lavandula pinnata</b>	A rounded bushy shrub with white-hairy grey-green leaves and spikes of 3-headed flowers throughout summer.	
<b>Lavender Hidcote</b>	A compact bushy shrub with narrow silvery grey leaves and spikes of dark purple flowers from mid to late summer. Ht 60cm	
<b>Lavender Stoechas Sanchez</b>	Spanish fat-headed lavender	
<b>Linum perenne Saphyr Blue</b>	Flax. Dwarf habit covered with mid blue flowers. Hardy rockery or edging plant. 30cm	
<b>Lupin Band of Nobles</b>	Well known flower plant taller than the Gallery mix	
<b>Lupin Gallery Mixed</b>	Dwarf variety with strong, densely packed flower spikes in strong colours. Hardy. 50cm	
<b>Lychnis chalconica Red</b>	An erect hardy perennial with mid-green leaves and rounded clusters of star-shaped scarlet flowers. 3 ft .Early summer - a welcome splash of red in the border.	
<b>Lychnis coronaria Red</b>	Pale purple or white flowers in summer. 45cm. Sun to part shade. Long flowering and gently self seeds.	
<b>Mertensia asiatica</b>	Thick, rubbery blue-green leaves. Spreading stems produce lovely sprays of soft blue flowers opening from pink buds. 6"	
<b>Nepeta Mussini Dwarf</b>	Low growing form of cat mint. Good at front of border or over a wall. Clip back after first flowering to allow repeat performance!	
<b>Nepeta subsessilis</b>	A clump-forming perennial with aromatic dark green leaves and bright blue flowerspikes from mid-summer to early autumn.	
<b>Osteospermum caulescens</b>	Hardy daisy flower making a mat of continuous flowering white in summer. Plant in full sun. Drought resistant.	
<b>Oxalis Pink</b>	A clump-forming perennial with clover-like grey-green leaves and pretty funnel-shaped, purplish pink flowers with darker veins.	

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<b>Oxalis triangularis</b>	A clump-forming perennial with purple-brown leaves and pretty light pink flowers in summer and autumn. 9". Sun or part shade.	
<b>Papaver alpinum champagne Bubbles</b>	Large cup-shaped flowers of yellow, peach, orange and white on bushy, strong stemmed plants. Foliage is grey green. 40cm	
<b>Papaver miyabeianum Pacino</b>	Grey-green leaves with compact habit. Produces lemon-yellow flowers 4-5cm across and decorative seed pods. Hardy	
<b>Papaver Orientalis Pizzicato</b>	Large flowered poppy . Single flowers with black centre. Hardy. 50cm	
<b>Penstemon Electric Blue</b>	Produces multiple stems with branched spikes holding intense blue flowers. Hardy	
<b>Perovskia</b>	Russian Sage. Grey green foliage with spikes of pale blue flowers August into autumn. Warm sheltered site for best results. 75cm	
<b>Persicaria Polygonum affinis</b>	A mat-forming, evergreen perennial with dark green leaves turning red in autumn and spikes of pale pink flowers becoming darker when mature.	
<b>Persicaria bistorta superba</b>	A clump-forming, semi-evergreen perennial with handsome mid-green leaves and short dense spikes of soft pink flowers. Likes a damp spot. 90cm	
<b>Phlox Subulata Pink</b>	A carpet of pink star shaped flowers on creeping evergreen foliage. Blooms for long period. Hardy. 15cm	
<b>Phyteuma scheuchzeri</b>	A tufted alpine with narrow leaves and rounded beautiful clusters of violet-blue flowers.12" tall.Plant in well drained soil	
<b>Polemonium Bambino Blue</b>	A clump-forming perennial with ferny dark green foliage and pretty blue flowers in late spring and early summer. 30cm	
<b>Potentilla atosanguinem</b>	Hardy perennial. Excellent for border. Will grow in any ordinary well-drained soil in full sun. flowers summer. Ht 18-24"	
<b>Pratia County Park</b>	An evergreen mat-forming alpine with pretty, star-shaped pale blue flowers in summer. Excellent ground cover doing well ion part shade. 3 cm	

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<b>Pratia Lobelia Penduncularis</b>	An evergreen mat-forming alpine with pretty, star-shaped sky blue flowers in summer.3cm.June/August	
<b>Primula auricula mixed</b>	An alpine primula with evergreen rosettes of rounded green leaves and clusters of deep yellow flowers in spring.	
<b>Prunella grandiflora carminea</b>	P. grandiflora 'Carminea' Bears short spikes of carmine-pink flowers from June to August. Small matt green leaves. Height 25cm. Spread 30cm often more.	
<b>Pulmonaria Lewis Palmer</b>	Bright blue Lungwort. Flowers early spring.	
<b>Pulsatilla vulgaris (Pasque flower)</b>	Traditional Easter flower of violet, upward facing bells with yellow centres. 25cm	
<b>Rudbeckia Fulgida Goldsturm</b>	A clump-forming perennial with mid-green leaves. Bright golden yellow daisy-like flowers with a blackish brown centre from late summer to mid-autumn. 60cm	
<b>Rudbeckia Purpurea Purple (Echinacea)</b>	3 ft tall, pink daisy flowers with reflex petals. July to October.	
<b>Salvia Gregii</b>	A dwarf evergreen shrub or sometimes a woody-based perennial with mid-green leaves. Spikes of red flowers from summer to autumn. 40cm	
<b>Salvia Patens Cambridge blue</b>	A tuberous perennial with hairy mid-green leaves. Large, PALE BLUE from mid-summer to mid-autumn. Height 45-60cm	
<b>Salvia Patens Dark blue</b>	A tuberous perennial with hairy mid-green leaves. DEEP BLUE flowers from mid-summer to mid-autumn.	
<b>Santolina chamaecyparissus Silver</b>	A compact rounded shrub with grey-white leaves. Yellow flowerheads from mid to late summer.	
<b>Santolina Tomentosa Green</b>	Hardy sub shrub . Dark green evergreen with pale yellow button flowers in summer.	
<b>Sedum Medio variegata</b>	A clump-forming perennial with upright stems of green & cream leaves. Dense clusters of starry pink flowers in late summer.24" Sunny position	

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<b>Sedum spathulifolium</b>	A mat-forming alpine with rosettes of silver-grey leaves. Clusters of star-shaped, bright yellow flowers in summer. Height 10cm. Spread 60cm. Flower colour Yellow. Flowers from June to August. Evergreen. Foliage colour Silver, Grey. Hardy.	
<b>Sedum Voodoo</b>	Deep intense reddish-bronze leaf colour contrasts with bright rose flowers. Forms a dense carpet of dark leaves. Hardy. Rockery. 15cm	
<b>Shasta Daisy (Leucanthemum) Crazy Daisy</b>	Ox-eye Daisy, Shasta Daisy. Perennial with dark green leaves and large daisy-like semi-double white flowers with yellow centres. 60cm	
<b>Sisyrinchium Palmifolium</b>	15-18" Each stem can carry up to 100 golden stars opening over a long period. Display begins mid morning and improves throughout the day. Something special!	
<b>Stachys lanata</b>	Lambs ears. Evergreen, mat-forming perennial with soft silver-grey foliage and violet flower spikes in summer. Hardy. 30cm	
<b>Stipa Arundacea Sirocco</b>	Pheasant's Tail Grass, a perennial with narrow leathery dark green arching leaves turning pink in winter. Cut back in March	
<b>Stipa Lessingiana</b>	A perennial grass with erect narrow bright green leaves. Soft feathery greenish white panicles ageing to buff throughout summer, remaining ornamental until late autumn.	
<b>Thalictrum Aquilegifolium</b>	An erect airy perennial with dainty leaves and fluffy deep lilac or white flowers in early summer. Ht 1m. Partial shade, adequate moisture	
<b>Thymus aurea</b>	Golden thyme. Low growing, mat forming herb.	
<b>Thymus serpyllum</b>	Mat forming thyme. Purple-violet flowers in May-Aug. Full sun	

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<b>Tradescantia Mauve/ White</b>	An erect arching perennial with narrow green leaves and clusters of magenta-pink or white flowers in summer and early autumn.	
<b>Tradescantia Virginiata Blue</b>	A clump-forming perennial with narrow green leaves and double light blue flowers in summer.	
<b>Verbena Bonariensis</b>	Tall, elegant plant topped with clusters of bright violet-blue flower heads. Effective in mixed border. Hardy. 90-120cm	
<b>Verbena La France</b>	An upright verbena having blue -purple fragrant flowers from June to 1st frosts. 30cm. Well drained position in sun. Border or container.	
<b>Veronica grandis</b>	Spikes of up to 12 inches of deep royal blue flowers on many 2-3ft stems which are lightly clad with pointed saw tooth leaves. Long flowering and rewarding. Plant mid to back of border.	
<b>Veronica penduncularis Georgia blue</b>	Low growing, mat-forming plant with green foliage, turning bronze in Winter. Free flowering most of the year. True blue. 30-40cm	
<b>Vinca major</b>		
<b>Vinca major variegata</b>		
<b>Viola cornuta</b>	Hardy viola of blues and white. Cut back from time to time to keep tidy. Long flowering period	
<b>Zauschneria californica</b>	Dry tolerant and sun loving this californian "Fuschia" with orange flowers gives colour through the summer. 30cm
