ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 (AS AMENDED)

WORCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(C2116 ELMLEY ROAD, ASHTON UNDER HILL)

(TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2010

NOTICE is hereby given that Worcestershire County Council intend, not less than seven days from the date of this Notice, to make an Order the effect of which is to close that part of C2116 Elmley Road, Ashton Under Hill from its junction with C2116 The Groaten to its junction with wood Lane.

The Order is being made to facilitate Central Networks works.

There are exemptions in the Order to permit access to any land or premises having a frontage to the highway affected where there is no other form of access; and to allow the necessary works to be undertaken.

The alternative route for those affected by the proposal will be via C2116 The Groaten, A46 Cheltenham Road, C2007 Hinton Cross to Elmley Castle, C2116 Elmley Castle to Ashton Under Hill and vice versa.

Proposed Temporary Orders can continue in force for a period not exceeding 18 months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out have been completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is expected that this Order will only be operative for 6 weeks commencing 24 July 2010.
